



## Annual Road Repairs

Yes it's that time of year again and this year's work will take place on Saturday 11th September, starting at 9.00AM with an estimated finish time of 1.00PM.

All plot holders are warned that there will be serious disruption with access to the site and along all the roads being repaired on that day; this includes rows C/D (Cherry Dell), E/F (Elderberry Farm), G/H (Gooseberry Hills) and the Top Road (Victory Row).

With that in mind, the committee asks that if you are not part of the Road Repair volunteer gangs, you should delay your visit to the site till later in the afternoon on Saturday 11th September.

Please also note that on Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> September and Friday 10<sup>th</sup> September work will be carried out to distribute scalping's around the site, these may be placed at certain points on the roads ready for the work parties to use on the Saturday. This may mean that you might not be able to drive directly to your plot. Please park accordingly.

Please come along and help with this important task; we hope to have around 30 volunteers as there is a large amount of repair work to carry out this year. We will expect to split the group into four working parties to cover as much of the site as we can. The more people that volunteer to help, the quicker the work will be done and reduce any disruption to all plot holders.

Volunteers; please don't forget to bring your wheelbarrows, rakes and shovels if you have them.

As in previous years, a FREE BBQ will be on offer to all volunteers following their hard work in repairing road damage caused by usage, weather and speeding car drivers.
