The current constitution does not impose a deadline for nominations. It only imposes a deadline for “business to be brought forward” (i.e. agenda items).

We decided to impose a 4 week deadline for nominations for the following reasons: a) it would be consistent with the 4 week deadline for agenda items; b) it would allow us time to prepare for the elections (voting papers etc.) and c) it would allow us time to let people know in advance who had been nominated so they could think about who to vote for.



Because the current constitution does not impose a deadline for nominations we believe that we should consider any that come in after the 4 week deadline we have imposed. Even those that may be made at the AGM itself. We believe the best way of doing this is to follow what has been proposed among the changes to the current constitution.

This will say that any nominations after the deadline will be put to the members at the meeting and they will be asked if they are happy to accept them by a show of hands. If the majority say “yes” then the person who has been nominated late will be added to the list and included for any voting.
